Families are well catered for, with seven childcare centres located conveniently close by, along with a good choice of schools, including Xavier Catholic School, Gwynne Park Primary School, Dale Christian School, Willandra Primary School, West Byford Primary School, Marri Grove Primary School, Forrestdale Primary School, Armadale Senior High School, John Calvin Christian College, Byford Secondary College, Southern Hills Christian College and Carey Baptist College.
